- Make sure that you have not applied for and received your bonus in the past.

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Welcome Home Bonus Information

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Chapter 130 Acts of 2005: Six months domicile in Massachusetts immediately prior to entry into the Armed Forces service beginning September 11, 2001.
- 2. Discharged must be under Honorable conditions.

Payment Information:

1. Active service in Afghanistan or Iraq:

\$1000.00

2. Six months or more active service, state side or outside the continental limits of the United States service:

\$500.00

* Active service shall not include active duty for training in the Army National Guard or Air National Guard, or active duty for training as a reservist in the armed forces of the United States.

How to Apply:

- 1. Complete, date, and sign the application.
- 2. Take or mail to the City or Town Clerk or Election Commissioner to secure Certification of residence where you were domiciled prior to entering the Armed Services.
- 3. Submit a complete and clear photocopy of ALL DD214s.

If still on Active Duty:

Commanding Officer must complete enclosed form.
